NOW COMES of the

with a Petition for Temporary Detention and

Examination in accordance with 405 ICLS 5/3-607 (Mental Illness) and/or 405 ILCS 5/4-

405 (Developmental Disability) of the Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities

Code stating as follows:

- 1. The Respondent is believed to be afflicted with a:
 - □ Mental Illness: Exhibiting behaviors consistent with a mental, or emotional disorder that substantially impairs their thoughts, perception of reality, emotional process, judgment, behavior, or ability to cope with the ordinary demands of life that are not the result of a developmental disability, dementia or Alzheimer's disease absent psychosis, a substance abuse disorder, or abnormality manifested only by repeated criminal or otherwise antisocial conduct. (405 ILCS 5/1-129)
 - □ Developmental Disability: A disability which is attributable to: (a) an intellectual disability, cerebral palsy, epilepsy or autism; or (b) any other condition which results in impairment similar to that caused by an intellectual disability and which requires services similar to those required by intellectually disabled persons. Such disability must originate before the age of 18 years, be expected to continue indefinitely, and constitute a substantial handicap. (405 ILCS 5/1-106)
- 2. The Respondent appears to be a person subject to involuntary admission on an inpatient basis and in need of immediate hospitalization to protect themselves or others from physical harm.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Petitioner requests this Honorable Court:

- A. Issue an order for the temporary detention and examination of the Respondent.
- B. Order an officer of the ______ department to take the

Respondent into custody and transport to

a mental health facility.

- C. That the Respondent be detained for no more than 24 hours to determine whether they are subject to immediate hospitalization and in need of involuntary admission.
- D. That if after examination it is determined that the Respondent is in need of immediate hospitalization and involuntary admission that the mental health facility prepare petitions and certificates in accordance with 405 ILCS 5/3-601 et seq. (mental illness/involuntary commitment) or 405 ILCS 5/4-400 et seq. (developmental disability/judicial commitment).
