The agency does not agree that the home she lives in is not independent living situation. Tabled last meeting, no consent.

10-070-9024 - an agency evicted a tenant from an apartment where he received mental health services and did not notify guardian. The agency set him up in a hotel with a meal voucher; however, it did not ensure that he continued receiving case management services, including a provision for the administration of medication. Tabled at the last meeting, no consent received.

11-070-9001 - general complaint to the Center has issued more restrictive hours for patient access to vending one visit @ 8 pm. It is noted that the Center denies patients the luxury of having food brought in from the outside and the vending machines are the only way to obtain foods to which the general public has access.
