

Egyptian Regional Human Rights Authority  
Meeting Minutes  
August 23, 2011

I: Call to Order:

The regular monthly meeting of the Egyptian Regional Human Rights Authority was called to order at 5:35 PM by the Chairperson, Pam O'Connor. The meeting was held at Jumbo's Meeting Room, 97 Red Bud Lane in Vienna.

II: Roll Call:

III: Determination of a Quorum: It was determined that a quorum was not present and all business conducted at this meeting would require ratification at the next meeting with a quorum present.

IV: Introduction by Chairperson: Chairperson O'Connor introduced Paul Jones to the re-appointed member.

V: Review and Approval of Minutes From the Previous Meeting: Rambeau moved to accept the minutes of the 06/28/11 HRA meeting as written. The motion was properly seconded (Livesay) and carried.

VI: Confidentiality Statement: The Chairperson stated that personally identifiable information should not be presented in public meetings to protect the privacy of those disabled persons on whose behalf the HRA conducts investigations. In addition, a printed confidentiality statement was posted.

VII: Communications. 1) The Authority Members reviewed a response from the provider for HRA Case No. 11-110-9032 (Chester Mental Health Center). 2) The Authority Members reviewed the HRA state statistics for the budget year of 2011. 3) The Coordinator informed the Members that the HRA Director would attend the next scheduled HRA to discuss the forthcoming year after the Coordinator's retirement.

VIII: New Business:

A ...New Complaints:

12-110-9001...1) During his stay in the facility infirmary, a recipient at a state-operated mental health facility was not allowed to have his personal clothing. 2) The recipient was not allowed to

receive a package sent by a family member. McMahan moved to accept the new complaint for investigation. The motion was properly seconded (Rambeau) and carried.

12-110-9002...Clients in a Seniors Program at a community workshop are not being provided with adequate care and services. The elder clients were moved from an area that was specifically designed for their needs. Five of the clients have been moved to a very small room, while the other ten clients have been placed in an area with younger clients. The move was implemented in order for newly admitted aggressive clients to be housed separately from the general client population in the area where the elder clients were located. Rambeau moved to accept the new complaint for investigation. The motion was properly seconded (McMahan) and carried.

12-110-9003....A community hospital is utilizing a restrictive restraint bed with netting to control aggressive patients in the hospital's emergency room. McMahan moved to table opening the issue for investigation until more information about the restraint bed can be obtained. The motion was properly seconded (Rambeau) and carried.

#### B...Election of Officers:

Livesay moved to maintain the same officers for the forthcoming year of 2012 as previous year (2011) (Pam O'Connor...Chairperson; Clarence Russell...Vice-Chairperson; and Kathy Rambeau, Secretary). The motion was properly seconded (McMahan) and carried.

#### D: Other New Business: None

Rambeau moved to enter closed session at 6:15 PM to discuss cases involving Chester Mental Health Center. The motion was properly seconded (Livesay) and carried. Paul Jones, Representative from Chester Mental Health Center, exited the room at 6:50 PM. After Jones departure the case involving Progressive Housing was discussed. The closed session ended at 7 PM. Coordinator Atherton summarized the closed session. Case status updates were given for four cases. Two Reports of Finding were approved as written, and two Reports of Findings were approved as written, subject to the HRA Director's approval. One Report of Findings was tabled for acceptance. One case was closed without issuing a Report of Findings. Another case was closed after the Authority accepted the facility's response to the findings and voted to make the finding a part of the public
