The regular scheduled meeting of the Human Rights Authority, South Suburban Region was called to order by Judith Rauls, Chairperson at 9:05 a.m.

I. CALL TO ORDER

The Chairperson read the confidentiality statement. It was determined that a quorum was present, and all business could be conducted. The meeting agenda was changed to accommodate our guests and introductions were made.

The Chairperson motioned to move the meeting into closed session at 9:09 a.m. pursuant to Section 3955/21 of the Guardianship and Advocacy Act to discuss the Southwest Community Services case #12-040-9004, the Advocate Christ Medical Center case #11-040-9001 and the Individual Advocacy Group case #12-040-9002 with the providers' representatives.

Open session reconvened at 10:00 a.m. having taken no action in closed session. A summary of closed session included three cases discussed with the provider's representatives.

The provider failed to provide a copy of the policy referenced in its previous response. The agency's Executive Director or Counsel did not attend the regional meeting as requested in the HRA's letter dated October 17th, 2011. Georgia Jones seconded and motion carried.
