The regular scheduled meeting of the Human Rights Authority, South Suburban Region was called to order by Judith Rauls, Chairperson at 9:10 a.m.

#### I. CALL TO ORDER

The Chairperson read the confidentiality statement. It was determined that a quorum was present, and all business could be conducted. Introductions were made. The meeting agenda was changed to accommodate our guests.

#### II. COMMUNICATION

It was moved by Kimberlee Brewerton to accept the February 9<sup>th</sup>, 2012 Meeting Minutes without changes. Motion was seconded by Georgia Jones and carried.

#### III. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

The Chairperson motioned to move the meeting into closed session at 9:15 a.m. pursuant to Section 3955/21 of the Guardianship Advocacy Act to discuss the Glenwood Healthcare & Rehabilitation Center case #12-040-9008 and, the Millennium Gardens case #11-040-9005 and 11-040-9006 with the providers' representatives. Theresa Buell moved the motion. Carol Genutis seconded and carried.

Open session reconvened at 9:30 a.m. having taken no action in closed session. A summary of closed session included three cases discussed with the provider's representatives.

12-040-9011 (Cila) Theresa Buell moved to accept the allegations regarding possible abuse and neglect pending the Office of the Inspector General's involvement in the complaint. The allegation about the lack of notification concerning the resident's hospitalization was also accepted for investigation. A signed Release of Information was received. Motion was seconded by Carol Genutis and carried. Kimberlee Brewerton and Judy Rauls were assigned to the case.

Although the provider disagrees with the HRA, the agency reportedly will obtain parents, guardians and other significant others' input concerning consensual sexual relations. A letter dated on February 16<sup>th</sup>, 2012 was sent to the agency's Counsel for a progress report, but the HRA did not receive a response. Michele Arthur seconded and motion carried.

11-040-9005 (Millennium Gardens) Carol Genutis moved to keep the case open for a copy of the revised policy and training documentation. Michele Arthur seconded and motion carried.

11-040-9010 (Timberline Knolls) A provider's response was not reviewed. The provider is still within the 30-day timeframe allowed to respond to the report of findings that contain violations. Carol Genutis moved to keep the case open. Michele Arthur seconded and motion carried.

11-040-9011 (Provena Saint Joseph Medical Center) On March 8<sup>th</sup>, 2012, the provider reported by phone that a response will be sent by next week. The provider is still within the 30-day timeframe allowed to respond to the report of findings that contain violations. Carol Genutis moved to keep the case open for a response. Michele Arthur seconded and motion carried.

11-040-9015 (Tinley Park Mental Health Center) The members' consensus was that the investigation should be continued although the facility is slated for closure on June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2012.
