### I. CALL TO ORDER

The Chairperson read the confidentiality statement. It was determined that a quorum was present, and all business could be conducted. The meeting agenda was changed to accommodate our guests.

### II. COMMUNICATION

The next meeting is scheduled at LARC on August 9<sup>th</sup>, 2012 at 9:00 a.m.


#### ANNOUNCEMENTS
