The regular scheduled meeting of the Human Rights Authority, South Suburban Region was called to order by Judith Rauls, Chairperson at 9:01 a.m.

I. CALL TO ORDER

The Chairperson read the confidentiality statement. It was determined that a quorum was not present and that all business could be conducted except for approving the meeting minutes and ratification of cases.

II. COMMUNICATION

Introductions were done. The May 9th, June 13th and August 8th, 2013 Meeting Minutes could not be approved because a quorum was not present.

The December 2012 through May 2013 Executive Meeting Minutes could not be approved because a quorum was not present.

The meeting agenda was changed to accommodate the guests.

III. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

The Chairperson motioned to move the meeting into closed session at 9:05 a.m. pursuant to Section 3955/21 of the Guardianship Advocacy Commission to discuss the Individual and Advocacy Group case #13-040-9001 with the provider's representatives. The member present consented to the motion.

Open session reconvened at 10:07 a.m. having taken no action in closed session. A summary of closed session included one case was discussed with the provider's representatives from Individual and Advocacy Group case #13-040-9001.

V. NEW COMPLAINTS

14-040-9001 (Nursing Home) The Chairperson motioned to accept the complaint involving the lack of coordination with community medical providers. The complainant withdrew the allegation about property because the issue reportedly has been resolved. A signed release of information was received. Lauren Pell gave her vote for a majority after the meeting. The case will be ratified at the next meeting.

14-040-9002 (Police Department) The Chairperson motioned to not accept the complaint involving excessive force and injuries for a formal investigation. The complaint will be pursued on an informal basis. The Coordinator will send a letter to the Chief of the Police Department requesting further investigation into the incident, departmental policies, information about police training, and a meeting to discuss how individuals with disabilities are handled. Lauren Pell gave her vote for a majority after the meeting. The case will be ratified at the next meeting.

14-040-9003 (Detention Center) The Chairperson motioned to not accept the complaint involving medication, medical services and, possible abuse and neglect. The Coordinator will send a letter to the complainant and suggest that she should file a grievance with the detention center. Lauren Pell gave her vote for a majority after the meeting. The case will be ratified at the next meeting.

14-040-9004 (Correctional Center) The Chairperson motioned to not accept the complaint involving the lack of accommodations to meet the recipient's disabilities, medication and medical concerns. The Coordinator will send a letter to the complainant and suggest that he should file a grievance with the Illinois Department of Corrections as suggested by another advocacy center and follow up with the Associate Warden at the correctional center. A signed release of information was not received to contact the correctional center on the recipient's behalf. Lauren Pell gave her vote for a majority after the meeting. The case will be ratified at the next meeting.

13-040-9001 (Individual Advocacy Group) The Chairperson motioned to keep the case opened for a copy of the facility's revised policy. The members present approved the motion. Lauren Pell gave her vote for a majority after the meeting. The case will be ratified at the next meeting.

Ratify Case Closure
