The regular scheduled meeting of the Human Rights Authority, South Suburban Region was called to order by Judith Rauls, Chairperson at 9:01 a.m.

I. CALL TO ORDER

The Chairperson read the confidentiality statement. It was determined that a quorum was not present and that all business could be conducted except for approving the meeting minutes.

II. COMMUNICATION

The November 14th, 2013 Meeting Minutes could not be approved because a quorum was not present.

III. NEW COMPLAINTS

14-040-9008 (Nursing Home) The Chairperson motioned to accept the complaint stating that a resident was not allowed to refuse medication in the absence of an emergency. A signed release of information was received. Maria Heer moved the motion and Michele Arthur seconded. Lauren Pell and Carol Genutis gave their votes subsequent to the meeting for a majority.

14-040-9009 (Residential Treatment Center) The Chairperson motioned to accept the complaint stating that a resident's well-being was compromised because she took an overdose of medication that was provided by a peer. It was reported that other recipient's well being was also compromised due to the incident. Additionally, the complaint alleged that the facility's assigned psychiatrist did not return the hospital's physician's call when the recipient was hospitalized following the incident. Maria Heer moved the motion and Michele Arthur seconded. Lauren Pell and Carol Genutis gave their votes subsequent to the meeting for a majority. The complaint was accepted pending a signed release of information.

IV. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

The Chairperson motioned to move the meeting into closed session at 9:18 a.m. pursuant to Section 3955/21 of the Guardianship Advocacy Commission to discuss the Individual and Advocacy Group case #13-040-9001 with the provider's representative, case assignments, progress reports, reports of findings, provider's responses and case closures. The members present consented to the motion.
